All lunch and supply charges are to be paid before Friday the 15. You can check with your child's elementary teacher or Mrs. Hiller to see an outstanding fees.

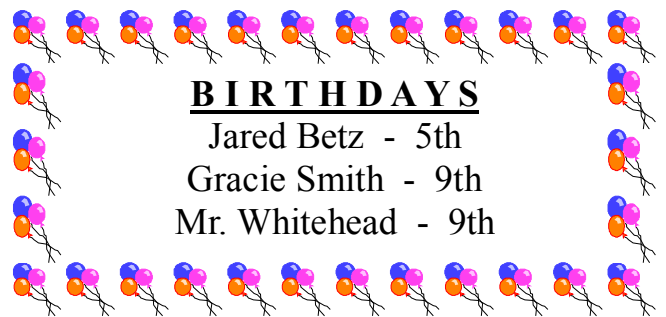
Label Contest
